The Associate in Ministry Certificate is a one-year program designed to provide instruction in basic Christian theological understandings and practice. This program is best suited for congregational staff and lay volunteers. It can also be used as ministry preparation for short term missionaries or anyone that wants to be better equipped in the basic teachings of the Bible, the history of the Christian church, and Christian theology.
